Guidelines for the Youth Bursary

Adopted at the Annual General Meeting, Yorkton, 2006-05-06.

Revised at the Annual General Meeting, Moose Jaw, 2013-04-27

1. The Bursary covers only participation in the Saskatchewan Branch Annual Workshop.
2. The applicant must be between the ages of 13 and 25 years and in full-time attendance at a recognised learning institution. Further, the registration fee for such youth attending the Branch Workshop shall be set at 80 per cent of the regular fee.
3. The applicant must submit a written application to the Branch Executive explaining the reason for the request and the benefit that the applicant's attendance at the workshop will be to the applicant and to the sponsoring Saskatchewan Group.
4. The written application must be accompanied by a written recommendation from the sponsoring Saskatchewan Group.
5. There shall be no limit to the number of bursaries that may be granted to each Annual Workshop.
6. Each Bursary shall be paid only for the portion of the Annual Workshop attended by each applicant.
7. The Branch Executive shall determine the amount of each bursary.
