

SASKATCHEWAN DANCERS

32 bar jig for three couples

Devised by George Ogilvie, 2004

Bars	Description
1-8	1 st couple cross right hands and cast below 2 nd couple; 1 st couple turn with the left hand and lead to places.
9-16	1 st man casts below 2 nd man and, followed by his partner, he then crosses up round 2 nd woman and finishes in 2 nd man's place while 1 st woman finishes in 2 nd woman's place. 2 nd couple move up on bars 15 & 16.
17-24	Corner, partner, corner, partner.
25-32	Inveran reels, 2 nd couple in first place cross over and dance round third places while 1 st couple dance up and out, 3 rd couple dance in and up.

Repeat, having passed a couple.

This dance is made up from formations taken from four dances which were favorites in Regina, Saskatoon, Yorkton and Moose Jaw during the time that Olive and George have been dancing.
